- 2. Unparalleled Scenery: Kiteboarding around Miavana offers breath-taking views of lush tropical landscapes, vibrant coral reefs, and exotic marine life. Glide over the sparkling ocean surface with the island's rich biodiversity as your backdrop.
- 3. Warm Water: The Indian Ocean around Miavana is beautifully warm, with water temperatures reaching up to 30°C (86°F). No wetsuits are needed for kiting here, but we have them available should you wish. It's the perfect place to ride comfortably for hours, with warm turquoise water as your playground.
- 4. Serene Seclusion: As a private island destination, Miavana provides an exclusive and secluded setting for kiteboarding. Guests can enjoy a tranquil environment that allows for uninterrupted kiteboarding sessions, making Miavana a true haven for adventure seekers.

KITING ON MIAVANA

With its steady trade winds, warm turquoise waters, and uncrowded beaches, Miavana is a kiter's paradise. The island offers incredible diversity, with conditions suited to every level, from absolute beginners to seasoned riders.

TURTLE BAY

After a 15-minute quad ride through forest trails, you'll arrive at the Kite Deck overlooking Turtle Bay. With its sandbanks, turquoise waters, and views of the lighthouse, it's the perfect place to learn, practice, or play; whether you're starting out, working on transitions and small jumps, or chasing new freestyle tricks. The team will guide you with gear and safety, while warm, waist-deep water makes for long, carefree sessions. And when it's time to pause, the deck awaits with snacks, drinks, and a post-session shower.

ANDRANGANA BAY

Steady off-shore winds and open waters make it an exciting playground for intermediate and advanced riders. With jet ski support always close by, you can explore the east side of the island, ride long tacks, and push into bigger jumps and tricks. On the rising tide, the bay opens opportunities to discover hidden coves along the coast, while advanced riders can venture further into the wave zone for strapless surf sessions, best enjoyed at high tide for safety.

DOWNWINDERS FROM MIAVANA

Downwind kiteboarding offers an unforgettable way to discover Miavana's beautiful coastline. Supported by our team with boat backup, these downwinders let you follow the wind across our turquoise waters with the freedom to ride at your own pace, jumping on the boat when you're ready for a break.

For those looking to explore further, guests can ride the downwind to/from the nearby islands of Nosy Manamphao and Nosy Vahala. Once there, sandbanks create perfect playgrounds for high jumps and freestyle tricks. When you've had your fill, enjoy some snacks or a light meal on a sheltered beach with just your footprints in the sand. Ride back to Miavana or enjoy a lovely boat trip back home.



DOWNWINDER SPOTS

NOSY MANAMPHAO

Manampaho, or Bird Island, is a playground for freestylers and cruisers alike. Its white sand beach and turquoise flat waters make it perfect for tricks, long runs, or simply soaking in the beauty of this uninhabited island. From May to September, it also becomes home to the largest colony of sooty terns in the western Indian Ocean; a rare chance to blend sport with nature. After hours on the water, you can return past sandbanks and reefs alive with turtles and fish, either by boat or on a downwind ride back to the Kite Deck.

NOSY VAHALA

For riders ready to stretch their distance, a downwind toward Nosy Vahala and the surrounding islets offers an unforgettable journey across turquoise channels and deeper waters. Along the way, you'll pass fishermen in their canoes, sharing a smile and a wave as turtles and schools of fish surface around you. Stronger winds and rolling waves set the stage for high jumps and strapless surfing. With boat support nearby, it's both a safe and exhilarating way to push your limits before ending the day back at the Kite Deck.

UPWIND AND DOWNWIND JOURNEYS

For advanced riders, there's also the option to take on upwind and downwind journeys between the Kite Deck, Manampaho, Andrangana Bay, and even Nosy Vahala. Lasting 2-4 hours, these routes are a chance to test your endurance while exploring new waters and discovering some of the most beautiful corners of the archipelago.

 challenging route linking three of our exciting spots






HELI KITING

A world-first experience exclusive to Miavana guests, heli-kiting unlocks kiteboarding locations otherwise out of reach. After flying over some of Madagascar's most beautiful and wild places, you'll touch down on a deserted beach to map out your own adventure, or head straight to some of the country's most renowned kiting spots. On board, the helicopter carries drinks, snacks, and a picnic lunch if you wish, letting you stay out on the water for as long as the wind calls.





HELI KITING SPOTS

AMBOLOBOZOKELY BAY

Accessible only by helicopter, Ambolobozokely Bay is a remote paradise best suited to intermediate and advanced riders. From the mangrove estuary to turquoise shallows and sandbanks, the bay offers a unique mix of flat-water play and long downwind runs, with a gentle current carrying you along. Along the way, you may spot fishermen watching in awe as kites dance across the sky. A support boat ensures safety throughout, while the helicopter shadows your route before whisking you back to Miavana on a breathtaking scenic flight. An unforgettable session in one of the island's most untouched playgrounds.

SAKALAVA BAY

Known for its steady winds and wide, shallow lagoon, Sakalava Bay offers ideal conditions for long, playful sessions. 

THE EMERALD SEA

The Emerald Sea is world-renowned for its dazzling turquoise waters and glassy, flat "swimming pool" conditions that are a dream for riders of all levels. Landing on Antalibe Island, you can set up gear and kite upwind to the spot or take a short transfer by vehicle. Known as a gathering place for kiteboarders and kite surfers, it's a joyful rendezvous where everyone shares their passion for the sport. After a long, playful session, you can cruise downwind back to Antalibe's beach for your helicopter pickup, closing the day in one of Madagascar's most iconic kiting destinations.


